The Office of Fair Trading has a book for consumers on how to identify and deal with scams called "The Little Black Book of Scams" which is available free on their web site at www.fairtrading.nsw.gov.au or by calling 13 32 20 or from Matt Brown's electorate office by calling 4232 1082. "When presented with any unsolicited offer, always keep in mind the old adage that if something sounds too good to be true, it usually is," Mr Brown said. Scams that are currently most common include pyramid selling, a number of overseas scams relating to lotteries and investments, offers of working from home, and door-to-door sales. Matt Brown urges local residents to become well informed about their consumer rights so that they may exercise them with confidence and minimise their risk of falling victim to a scam.
